What to bring:

- Comfortable cloths, good walking shoes and rain gear. Be prepared to be outside all day. Bring a mix of warm and cool clothes. (Sweat pants work for climbing while jeans are discouraged.)
- Sleeping bag, day pack, water bottle and sunscreen

Weekend Overview:

Pathfinder Clubs will meet at Mid-Columbia SDA School (1100 22nd St, Hood River OR 97031) on Friday evening where a light supper will be provided. Friday evening activities will include getting to know each other and learning more about God. After breakfast on Sabbath we will head out to the climbing area for worship, hiking and challenge activities. Sabbath evening we will be back at the school for supper and other evening activities. Sunday will be spent out on the rock. Climbing will wind down around 2:00 pm on Sunday.
